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## Grant Funding Policy

1. The Survive and Save Club wishes to support all its teachers, lifeguards and other volunteers in whatever role they undertake by providing them with training grants. These grants are awarded to help you fully develop the skills necessary in order to fulfil your role to the best of your ability.
2. Grant Application forms are available from the Club Treasurer or Secretary upon application.
3. Applicants will be required to apply for external grant funding where available and funding rules allow such applications. Details of these funding sources are available from the Secretary or other designated officer.
4. Completed application forms should be handed in to the Secretary or Treasurer as soon as possible after applying for a course. Applications submitted after the course has started will not be accepted.
5. Applications for grant funding will be reviewed at the next Finance Sub Committee.
6. You will be advised in writing of the decision including the amount of Grant funding and approximate date of release.
7. Where the grant is over £50 you will be asked to sign a simple contract as a form of acceptance which allows the club to reclaim some of its grant funding should you decide to leave the Club within a 2 year period.
8. Subject to approval grant funding will be released 6 months after the course has been successfully completed.
9. Any queries regarding your Grant Application should be directed to the Club Treasurer.
10. The fact that the Survive and Save Club has a grant giving policy does not mean that funding will automatically be available to applicants on every occasion. There may be times when grant funding from the Club is restricted or unavailable.
