Swimming and Lifesaving Teacher

Role

Teach swimming and life saving to members of all ages and ability to ensure development and progression.

Skills

- Be an excellent and effective communicator that is approachable, clear and concise
- Be a good listener
- Ability to inspire confidence and motivate swimmers
- Be able to work a part of a team
- Organised
- Punctual

Main Duties

- Assist the Swim co-ordinator in delivering the Club's teaching and life saving programmes
- Plan, deliver and evaluate all sessions in line with a prepared scheme of work
- Teach swimming and life saving to groups ensuring that each swimmer is provided with suitable activities to ensure progression to the next level
- Record attendance
- Responsible for discipline and safety of your group during sessions, but keeping it fun
- Record and report all injuries and incidents
- Clear away all equipment at the end of your session
- Complete swimmer assessments and reports as required
- Comply with the Swim England/RLSS and club Codes of Ethics and Conduct
- Undertake regular CPD to develop and improve skills and knowledge
- Attend teachers meetings

Commitment

- Arrive at least 10 minutes before the start of your first session and prepare your teaching area and equipment
- Start and finish all sessions on time
- Up to 3 hours teaching per week
- 3 teachers meetings per year

Qualifications

- Swimming Teachers must hold as a minimum:
 - ASA Level 2 Teaching Swimming or equivalent
 - Suitable qualifications to teach Swim England stages 8-10 including Rookie Lifeguard
- Life Saving Teachers must hold:
 - Trainer Assessor / Lifesaving Instructor or equivalent
 - Life Support 3 (renewed every 24 months)

- RLSS Membership (renewed every 12 months)
- Rookie Instructor

Other qualifications, certificates and requirements

- All teachers must have
 - Safeguarding and Protecting Children Workshop (updated every 3 years)
 - DBS reference (updated every 3 years for Swim England and every 2 years for RLSS as required)
- Desirable
 - RLSS National Pool Lifeguard Qualification **OR**
 - RLSS National Rescue Award for Swimming Teachers and Coaches
 - Hold IOS professional indemnity insurance (or equivalent)
