Teacher/Trainer

Role

Teach swimming and life saving to members of all ages and ability to ensure development and progression.

Skills

- Be an excellent and effective communicator that is approachable, clear and concise
- Be a good listener

- Be able to work a part of a team

Qualifications

- Swimming Teachers must hold as a minimum:
 - ASA/UKCC Level 1 Certificate for Teaching Aquatics or equivalent **OR**
 - ASA/UKCC Level 1 Certificate for Coaching Swimming or equivalent
 - National Pool Lifeguard Qualification **OR**
 - National Rescue Award for Swimming Teachers and Coaches
 - ASA Teachers Licence
- Life Saving Teachers must hold:
 - RLSS Trainer Assessor **OR**
 - Lifesaving Instructor
 - Life Support 3
 - National Pool Lifeguard Qualification **OR**
 - National Rescue Award for Swimming Teachers and Coaches
 - RLSS Membership

Main Duties

- Assist the head teacher/programme co-ordinator in delivering the Club's teaching and life saving programmes
- Plan, deliver and evaluate all sessions in line with a prepared scheme of work
- Teach swimming and life saving to groups to ensure progression to the next level
- Complete swimmer assessments and reports as required
- Responsible for discipline and safety of your group during sessions
- Record and report all injuries and incidents
- Undertake regular CPD to develop and improve skills and knowledge
- Attend teachers meetings

Time Commitment

Up to 3 hours per week
